

## **Interoperability day**

### ***Background***

SFTI (Single Face To Industry) arranges an interoperability test and invites all parties that supports the basic transport profile (based on ebXML MS version 2). Participation is free of charge.

The purpose of the interoperability day is to facilitate an organized testing procedure and test cases.

### ***Basic Transport Profile***

SFTI Transport Profile Bas is a specification for simple electronic communication between business partners and/or intermediaries acting on their behalf. The profile "Bas" is designed for simplified communication of a message, that contains one or more documents, and one message in return as acknowledgment of receipt.

The profile is based on the ebXML framework and its ebXML Message Service Specification [ebMS] Version 2.0. The ebXML Framework has been developed by UN/CEFACT in collaboration with OASIS and their constituent parts are ISO standards.

The "Basic" profile is derived from the ebXML Framework with several of its options excluded. It does not require a full [ebMS] message handling service implementation, but may be implemented with limited resources based on commonly available knowledge and technologies.

As the "Basic" profile is a strict sub-set of the ebXML Framework, parties who wish to utilize additional functionality in their business communications can easily upgrade within the ebXML Framework, for example by adding reliability and security features.

### ***Who can participate?***

All system vendors or users that support the basic transport profile. Parties that use only sending systems, or only receiving systems can also test these specific situations.

### ***Practical arrangements***

We will meet "face-to-face" in a conference room but all participants need to be able to remote control their applications. It will not be possible to run any receiving applications in the conference room due to firewall policies.

So - all applications need to be accessible on the Internet.

### **Configuration of applications**

SFTI will in advance provide configuration settings such as party identifiers, service/action values and CPA-Ids.
